The Stewardship Effort Hierarchy

- 1) Deer, Deer, Deer → deer
- 2) Invasives
 - Emerging Invasive Species Control / Eradication
 - ► Stage 0, then Stage 1, etc.
 - ▶ Invasives on High Conservation Value Lands
 - ► Rare species habitat and old forests
- 3) Restore

2018 Target Species

102 plants + 47 "animals"
