We are pleased to provide a free service that brings native plants to your yard!

By combining orders from multiple participants, we provide access to participating nurseries offering wholesale and discounted retail pricing.

You'll save lots of money while beautifying your property and improving the ecological health of the Hopewell Valley!

1) Select Your Plants -Send your order to Mike

- Check out all of the great native plants!
 - o Click Common Names on the order form to view a web link containing information and photographs
 - o If Mike has already visited, he'll provide recommendations tailored to your home.
- Select Plant Sizes and Quantities on the order form
 - o Flats of 'Plant Plugs' Ranging from 32 to 72 plants per flat. You must order entire flats!
 - o Price Range: \$40 to \$75 per flat [equivalent to \$0.85 \$2.50 per plant]
 - o Great for creating a small meadow plug roots are 2-4" deep
 - o Nurseries: New Moon, North Creek, and Pinelands
 - o Individual Pots Typical pot sizes range from Pint to Gallon
 - o Price Range: Wildflowers/Ferns: \$4 to \$7 each; Trees/Shrubs: \$8 \$12 each
 - o Nurseries: Pinelands, Toadshade and Wild Ridge
- Ordering Deadlines
 - o Spring Deadline March 25, 2019; Fall Deadline August 5, 2019

2) FoHVOS Places Order with Participating Nurseries

- FoHVOS confirms availability and pricing with nurseries.
- We'll request your 'OK' before placing the final order with nurseries. Prorated shipping costs are calculated and added to the cost of your plants. FoHVOS *does not* add any costs for our time to manage the program.

3) Payment and Plant Pick-Up

- <u>Payment</u>: Upon receiving your final order total, mail checks to Friends of Hopewell Valley Open Space, P.O. Box 395, Pennington, NJ 08534. Please add "PLSP" in the note section of your check.
- <u>Timing</u>: Approximate plant pick up dates: Spring May 17, 2019; Fall September 13, 2019
- <u>Pick-Up Location</u>: Plants will be in a gated garden area attached to the rear of our old office at Washington Crossing State Park. If you are in the back of the building, it will be on the right side.

Pick up any time (including evenings and weekends).

• <u>Directions to Our Old Office</u>: Located 1/4 mile west of the main entrance to Washington Crossing State Park on Washington Crossing-Pennington Road. Mailboxes for 495 and 495A are directly across the street from our driveway (marked "Authorized Vehicles Only"). Turn into the driveway and our office is the historic white house on your left. Proceed to the parking lot behind the office.
