- **NOTE:** We provide convenience of placing orders and bringing them to Hopewell for you to pick up. But both nurseries allow direct orders through their websites and can ship plants to your home.

#### **Plant Ordering:**

We have developed an ordering system to make it easier for you to select the right plants for your yard. It includes a tally of costs in your 'Cart' as you shop - costs include both the plants and shipping costs.

- Plant Selection and Availability
  - Selection: We can only offer species listed on our website. Utilize the various filters by plant attributes to find the perfect plants for your yard and/or feel free to reach out to Mike any time.

- Availability: If a species is known to be currently unavailable, you won't be able to add it
  to your cart. We will not hold orders placed in spring for fall delivery. If not available in
  spring, you will have to try again for fall.
  - IMPORTANT NOTE: Nursery availability can change daily, so it is quite possible that something initially available will become unavailable by the time we place orders with nurseries. We will subtract unavailable plants from your original order once everything is finalized usually about 1-2 weeks after orders close. Payments are due upon confirming final availability of all plants in your order (See Below).

### Ordering Deadlines

- Spring Midnight, Sunday, March 3; Notification of final order availability and total amount due approximately March 21.
- Fall Midnight, Sunday August 18; Notification of final order availability and total amount due approximately August 30.

## **Plant Payments:**

We will provide your amount due, including shipping, upon confirming your final order (see above). Payments can be made by check or online.
